Steps to become a Command Religious Lay Leader

Step 1: Ask yourself the question: Are you a mature person of faith that desires to continue the practice of that faith in the military environment and help lead others to do the same?

Step 2: Make an appointment to see your unit chaplain to discuss what your faith means to you, your desire to lead, and understand the needs of the command religious program, and your eligibility for potentially becoming a certified Lay Leader.

Step 3: Reach out to your religious organization (RO) leadership/pastor wherever you attend/have attended worship services for a short letter of endorsement following the template that you will receive from your chaplain.

Step 4: Submit your endorsement letter to your chaplain and request to be signed up for Lay Leader Training/Workshop.

Step 5: Submit training certificate to your chaplain who will then route entire package to the CO for endorsement, after which you can officially begin your duties as a Command Lay Leader.
